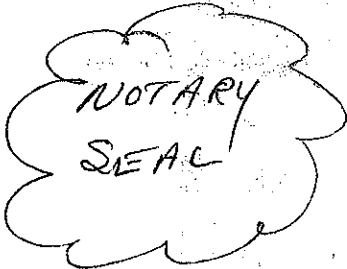

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

BE IT KNOWN, that the undersigned, at least three of whom are residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and citizens of the United States, and all of whom are of full age, having associated themselves together for the purpose of organizing the LEHIGH WHEELMEN ASSOCIATION, INC., and being desirous of becoming incorporated in accordance with the provisions and requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania known as the "Nonprofit Corporation Law", approved May 5, 1933, as amended, do hereby declare, set forth and certify as follows:

1. That the name of the corporation is the Lehigh Wheelmen Association, Inc. and that said name has been registered with the Pennsylvania Department of State within six months of the date of the application for this charter, per the certificate which is made a part hereof as an exhibit.

2. That the location and post office address of its initial registered office in this Commonwealth is 511 S. Leh St., Allentown, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania.

3. That the purposes of the corporation are to promote the general interests of cycling in all its phases; to encourage and facilitate touring runs, cycle outings, cycle trains, competitive racing, and all forms of recreational cycling activities; to defend and protect the rights of cyclists; to secure a better understanding and recognition of the need for safer riding conditions; to encourage the allocation of facilities for cycling on

public lands; to cooperate with the public authorities in the observance of all traffic regulations; and to advocate the registration of bicycles in the interest of safety, proper regulation and recognition of the bicycle as a vehicle used for pleasure, health and economical transportation.

4. That this is a corporation which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise, to its members.

5. That the term of its existence is perpetual.

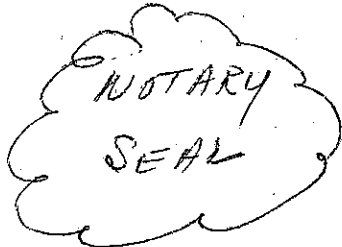

ORDER OF COURT

to all of the duties, requirements and restrictions specified and enjoined in and by the said "Nonprofit Corporation Law", and all other applicable laws of this Commonwealth.
